The Community Care Kitchen serves hot take-out meals three times per month at Vincent United Methodist Church (100 Vincent Place in Nutley) on the second, third and last Saturdays of each month from 11:30-12:30. Prepared and shared by people from Vincent Church, Grace Church, Holy Trinity Church, St. Mary's Church, and Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church, the meal might be chicken or beef or pasta with delicious sides and vegetables. Everyone is welcome to come by the Community Care Kitchen and pick up a meal-to-go including families and seniors. Please bring a large bag or two to carry the food. In these tough times, there is a growing need and the churches are partnering with others in our community to make a difference in the world. Upcoming dates are May 13, 20, and 27. We are proud to partner with the Community Food Bank of New Jersey and to serve as a GNJUMC Hope Center.

Care Pantry Needs

Our Care Pantry provides personal care items for families in need in our area. We have seen about a 50% increase in numbers. We are in need of paper towels, household cleaners, dish detergent, and toilet

paper. People could purchase the items and leave them in or on the bin by the left front door of the church. Thank you!

Reusable Bags for Care Pantry

We understand that supermarket delivery services are sending orders now in reusable bags. If you end up with more bags than you need, the Care Pantry would gladly receive clean and barely used bags. The Care Pantry would like to go "green" and needs 80 or more bags each month. To donate clean and barely used reusable bags, leave them by the Care Pantry located to the left of the elevator on our main floor.

Church Website

Rev. Benitez' Prayer Ministry

Rev. Benitez of our church, a retired United Methodist minister and District Superintendent from the Philippines, is serving us as our prayer minister. He prays daily for those people on our prayer list and situations lifted by our congregation. His and all our prayers for those in need and for the ministry of our church help undergird all that we do. Thank you Rev. Benitez and may we all be encouraged and uplifted by his prayer ministry among us.

Handicapped Parking

Our church has three handicapped parking places, two by the lower door to the Education Building and one at the very top of the upper lot. It is requested that everyone respect those spaces and leave them for those who need them. It is one way that we can show hospitality and compassion as followers of Jesus.

Vincent UMC Safety Protocol

Our church has developed some safety protocols in case of a fire, medical or security emergency. Our ushers and Church School staff have been trained as to how to proceed with different situations. If you see a situation that needs attention, please speak to one of the ushers for assistance. This might include smoke or fire, someone in medical distress, or someone whose behavior is erratic or makes one uncomfortable. If you see something, please say something to an usher who will then address the situation. We want our church to be a welcoming, safe, and peaceful setting for our worship and service of God.

AED Available for Emergency Use

Our church has an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) which can diagnose and defibrillate someone having a heart attack. On opening it, the AED has simple audio and visual commands that are designed to be used by any layperson. It is located in a marked metal box in the hallway to the chapel. While we pray it will never be used, it is available if a heart emergency arises.

First Aid Kit and "Stop the Bleed" Trauma Kit

Our church has a First Aid Kit and a "Stop the Bleed" Trauma Kit. They are located on the door in the Usher's Closet opposite the Ladies Room. They contain items needed in case of a medical emergency. While we pray they never need to be used, they are available in the case of an emergency.

<u>"Upper Room" Devotional Guides Available</u>
"Upper Room" Devotional Guides are now available for free for pickup in the literature rack in the front church vestibule. They contain a short devotional for each day for two months with a theme, a scripture, a reflection, a prayer, and a thought for the day. They are small and can be used on a breakfast table, on a nightstand, in a briefcase or pocketbook. Pick one up to use as one way to stay grounded in and to grow in faith in Jesus Christ.

Memorial Book

Our church maintains a book of all Memorial Fund Donations received, elegantly noting the one remembered and the donors. It is located in a display case in the front vestibule of the church. The glass cover lifts and folks are welcome to peruse it. Thank you to Marilyn Carlson for tending to this with great care as the Memorials Secretary.

Calling All Nurses and Emergency Personnel

Our church is looking to update its list of church family who are nurses, emergency personnel, or CPR trained and who would be willing to be called upon if they are at church when there is a medical emergency, especially on Sunday mornings. NJ Energy Bills Assistance

If you are struggling to pay your energy bills, help is available. The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and Universal Service Fund (USF) have expanded to include more people at higher income levels. For example, a family of four with a monthly income of \$9,250 may be eligible and should apply for the USF. (Only the last month of income counts.) If you are not eligible for LIHEAP or USF, there are moderateincome programs, such as the PAGE Grant and/ or NJ SHARES, which may provide the help you need. For






